- The top 5% attained averages over 78.20%
- The top 10% attained averages over 77.30%
- The top 20% attained averages over 74.40%
- The top 30% attained averages over 73.00%
- The top 50% attained averages over 70.30%
- The top 75% attained averages over 66.00%

SECOND YEAR

- The top 5% attained averages over 80.83%
- The top 10% attained averages over 78.67%
- The top 20% attained averages over 76.83%
- The top 30% attained averages over 75.80%
- The top 50% attained averages over 73.60%
- The top 75% attained averages over 71.00%

THIRD YEAR

- The top 5% attained averages over 82.30%
- The top 10% attained averages over 80.40%
- The top 20% attained averages over 77.50%
- The top 30% attained averages over 76.50%
- The top 50% attained averages over 74.17%
- The top 75% attained averages over 70.60%
