Russell Brown is a justice of the Supreme Court of Canada. He was previously a member of the courts of Alberta, the Northwest Territories and Nunavut, prior to which he was a professor of law and associate dean (graduate studies) at the University of Alberta, where he remains an honorary professor of law. He was a research fellow of the Health Law & Science Policy Group and a fellow of the Alberta Institute for American Studies. He also served as chair of the Health Law Institute at the University of Alberta, chair of the University Appeals Board and Professional Review Board, and as a member of the governing board of the Canadian Forum on Civil Justice. Justice Brown is a member of the editorial board of the University of Toronto Law Journal and is an advisor to the Legal Writing Academy at the University of Ottawa.
