




CLASSIC IN BRIEF

DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR

1. CLINICAL INTENSIVE

- WHAT: The Intensive is like doing WAC full-time! • Work at CLASSIC from Mon-Thur, 9 AM - 5 PM
- Friday seminar with a major paper •
- Get 15 credits! (The Intensive is your only class.) • Offered in both terms
- HOW: Apply directly to the clinical instructor during course selection time. Watch for e-mails with the application.

**Available to 2nd and 3rd year students only.

HOW: Apply through PBSC. Watch for notices from PBSC about when and how to apply.
