### **SECOND YEAR**

- The top 5% attained averages 80.80% and over
- The top 10% attained averages 79.20% and over
- The top 20% attained averages 76.70% and over
- The top 30% attained averages 73.70% and over
- The top 50% attained averages 71.30% and over
- The top 75% attained averages 66.60% and over

### **THIRD YEAR**

- The top 5% attained averages 82.30% and over
- The top 10% attained averages 81.00% and over
- The top 20% attained averages 78.20% and over
- The top 30% attained averages 76.20% and over
- The top 50% attained averages 72.70% and over
- The top 75% attained averages 68.40% and over
