



**University of Saskatchewan College of Law Distribution of Averages, May 2011**

The final results in the 2010 – 2011 year show the following approximate patterns of individual student averages.

**First Year**

- the top 5% attained averages over 78%
- the top 10% attained averages over 76.1%
- the top 20% attained averages over 74.4%
- the top 30% attained averages over 73%
- the top 50% attained averages over 70.8%
- the top 75% attained averages over 67.5%

**Second Year**

- the top 5% attained averages over 82%
- the top 10% attained averages over 79.6%
- the top 20% attained averages over 77.4%
- the top 30% attained averages over 75.4%
- the top 50% attained averages over 73.6%
- the top 75% attained averages over 70.2%

**Third Year**

- the top 5% attained averages over 84%
- the top 10% attained averages over 80%
- the top 20% attained averages over 78.5%
- the top 30% attained averages over 77.4%
- the top 50% attained averages over 73.7%
- the top 75% attained averages over 70%
