The final results in the 2011-2012 year show the following approximate patterns of individual student averages. These take into account the changes to Section 1 First Year grades made on May 9, 2012.

First Year

- The top 5% attained averages over 81.1%
- The top 10% attained averages over 76.7%
- The top 20% attained averages over 73.9%
- The top 30% attained averages over 72.8%
- The top 50% attained averages over 71.0%
- The top 75% attained averages over 66.8%

Second Year

- The top 5% attained averages over 82.3%
- The top 10% attained averages over 78.9%
- The top 20% attained averages over 77.4%
- The top 30% attained averages over 76.2%
- The top 50% attained averages over 73.5%
- The top 75% attained averages over 69.8%

Third Year

- The top 5% attained averages over 83.6%
- The top 10% attained averages over 80.4%
- The top 20% attained averages over 77.4%
- The top 30% attained averages over 76.2%
- The top 50% attained averages over 73.7%
- The top 75% attained averages over 71.3%
