- The top 5% attained averages 81.80% and over
- The top 10% attained averages 79.70% and over
- The top 20% attained averages 77.20% and over
- The top 30% attained averages 76.20% and over
- The top 50% attained averages 74.00% and over
- The top 75% attained averages 71.30% and over

**THIRD YEAR**

- The top 5% attained averages 84.10% and over
- The top 10% attained averages 81.40% and over
- The top 20% attained averages 78.10% and over
- The top 30% attained averages 77.17% and over
- The top 50% attained averages 75.20% and over
- The top 75% attained averages 73.00% and over
