- The top 30% attained averages 77.11% and over
- The top 50% attained averages 75.11% and over
- The top 75% attained averages 72.00% and over

**THIRD YEAR**

- The top 5% attained averages 83.33% and over
- The top 10% attained averages 82.60% and over
- The top 20% attained averages 80.25% and over
- The top 30% attained averages 78.60% and over
- The top 50% attained averages 76.67% and over
- The top 75% attained averages 74.00% and over
