- The top 50% attained averages 74.44% and over
- The top 75% attained averages 70.50% and over

THIRD YEAR

- The top 5% attained averages 84.50% and over
- The top 10% attained averages 83.20% and over
- The top 20% attained averages 80.11% and over
- The top 30% attained averages 78.44% and over
- The top 50% attained averages 75.71% and over
- The top 75% attained averages 72.63% and over
