

Stephen is a widely recognized economist with nearly 40 years of experience in financial markets, forecasting, and economic policy, including 35 years in the public sector.

Prior to joining Osler, Stephen was the 9th Governor of the Bank of Canada. He was Governor of the Bank for seven years

after having previously spent 14 years there during 1981-95 occupying a range of increasingly senior positions.

Drawing on his recent book, *The Next Age of Uncertainty*, Stephen Poloz will speculate on how individuals and businesses will adapt to this ever-shifting landscape. The global economy is being buffeted by an unusual confluence of forces presently. These forces will continue to grow in strength in the next 10-20 years, resulting in a rising tide of economic and financial volatility.
